Our Social Media policy can be summarized by 3 P's.

PURPOSE

- To encourage and stay in contact with our Church Family and the Community.
- To be a Christian outreach to people who don't know Jesus and to encourage them to join us at TPC, by sharing the Gospel with them.
- To communicate the ministries of TPC.
- To communicate the work our Mission partners, do.
- To engage, encourage, enable and equip TPC members to grow into complete followers of our Lord Jesus Christ

POLICY

- We will share only Christian values and principles.
- We will endeavour to show our Church family and the community the love of Jesus.
- We will respect and protect the privacy and security of our members.
- We will seek permission before sharing any photos on social media.
- We will ensure our social media platforms are safe; and not conversation channels; and ensure any conversations, debates or opinions are taken offline.
- Our Administrator¹ will respond to any comments or questions; and will delete any posts or comments which contain inappropriate or offensive language and opinions.
- Our Administrator will remove any controversial or offensive comments or posts.
- Our Administrator will block any users who do not conform to our social media policy.
- Our Administrator will regularly review and update social media settings to ensure the right controls are in place.

PLAN

- Engage with people on a consistent basis (preferably daily) by supplementing the weekly sermons with thoughtful and encouraging posts.
- Ensure weekly sermons and children's talks, where possible, are loaded to social media.
- Promote all ministries, events and key moments at TPC.
- Regularly review our followers and their feedback to ensure that we are properly fulfilling our TPC Mission and Vision.
